

GOD HAS DONE AMAZING THINGS through this ministry, our community of supporters, our partners, and our volunteers in 2024. Never before have we served over 2,600 women-an increase of almost 20% over 2023! What do we attribute this to? The Lord is obviously moving to bring these women through our doors, even as we see the thief working to kill, steal, and destroy lives in South Hampton Roads.

Abortion providers are actively online, targeting women with abortion pills, which are becoming available at an unprecedented rate. Even the Satanic Temple is offering discounted abortion pills online, specifically targeting women in Virginia. But we are doing everything we can to reach these women before they do.



We invested even more heavily in

our online advertising and outspent abortion providers in 2024. We also increased our call center hours and staff, our facilities, our medical staff, and our patient advocacy team to offer women, like Hailey (next page), a sameday appointment. Same-day appointments are crucial to reaching women who are making life-and-death decisions.



Each of the women we serve has a unique story, and each story also includes dads and families. With the increase in patients, we served nearly 400 families in our parenting classes last year-an increase over 2023none of which would have been possible without our new Great Expectations Parenting Support Center in Chesapeake.

In 2024, the Lord allowed us to intervene for more preborn children, and their mothers and fathers, like never before in the history of this ministry! I am so grateful for His mercy on this community and His provision for this ministry. As we have been serving so many more,

our expenses have been going up significantly. We are so grateful for the support of our partners and community!

shares Hailey, a patient of CPC's pregnancy medical clinics. Hailey was going through a breakup and


was homeless at the time. "I was driving in my car. and I was talking to God, and I was like, just please show me why I'm here, because I don't know."

But something-or Someone made Hailey turn around. A few weeks later, she found out she was pregnant. "I was like, 'Oh my God. You heard me. You heard my prayers!""

Initially, Hailey was in shock, as she didn't think she was able to carry a child. Her sister suggested

she reach out to CPC. "They were so sweet and so welcoming and so calming. ... They didn't give me an inkling of feeling judged or any uncertainty."

There, she saw her 12-week-old baby on an ultrasound for the first time. "Honestly, seeing him and actually believing that I was pregnant-it literally changed my life. I became a mom in that moment."

The CPC staff was excited for Hailey and her new baby, and they called throughout her pregnancy to see how she and her baby were doing. "To see so many people excited for me and happy that I'm happy, and happy that the baby is happy-it was just insane to me," she remembers. "I never thought I would feel welcomed anywhere like I had there."

Now, Hailey recommends CPC to other uncertain new moms. "From that moment I walked into CPC's pregnancy medical clinic, my life has completely changed, and I'm so thankful."

CPC's faithful monthly financial partners, whom we call LIFEkeepers, are critical to sustaining this ministry month in and month out.
